





MERRIAM WEBSTER - THE ACTION OF UNDERSTANDING, BEING AWARE OF, BEING SENSITIVE TO, AND VICARIOUSLY EXPERIENCING THE FEELINGS, THOUGHTS, AND EXPERIENCE OF ANOTHER OF EITHER THE PAST OR PRESENT WITHOUT HAVING THE FEELINGS, THOUGHTS, AND EXPERIENCE FULLY COMMUNICATED IN AN OBJECTIVELY EXPLICIT MANNER.



CHRIS VOSS CALLS IT "TACTICAL EMPATHY" —

TACTICAL EMPATHY IS BECOMING COMPLETELY AWARE OF THE OTHER SIDE'S PERSPECTIVE, THEIR POINT OF VIEW, THEIR TAKE ON THINGS, HOW THEY SEE IT, AND WHAT THEY FEEL. IT'S NOT AGREEING WITH THEM.

Attribution Theory

Definition: Explaining someone's behavior by either their personality traits (disposition) or the situation they are in (situation).

Fundamental Attribution Error: underestimate the power of a situation and overestimate the power of someone's disposition



PREPARATION


- DO NOT WAIT, BAD NEWS DOESN'T GET BETTER WITH TIME (BUT WAIT LONG ENOUGH TO HAVE ALL THE FACTS)
- EXAMINE YOUR INTENT
- IS THIS PROBLEM YOUR FAULT OR PARTIALLY YOUR FAULT?
- TALK WITH YOUR PEERS ABOUT THE CONVERSATION FIRST. GET PERSPECTIVE FROM OTHERS.



LOCATION

CRITICAL CONVERSATIONS

- BEGINS WITH TRUST HAVE YOU BUILT A RELATIONSHIP?
- DOES THE TRAINEE BELIEVE YOU HAVE THEIR BEST INTEREST AT HEART?
- IF YOUR TRAINEE FEELS SAFE, THEY WILL BE MORE OPEN TO YOUR CONSTRUCTIVE CRITICISM.





- LOOK OUT FOR "FIGHT OR FLIGHT"


 OR "SILENCE OR VIOLENCE"
